- **Question 1:** We see that a principal at R3 Consulting Group is the Executive Director and have performed most of this type of work over the years. Is the RWMA specifically looking for someone to perform this scope of work independent of R3?
 - **RWMA Response:** Yes. RWMA is seeking an independent third-party review of Recology's Extraordinary Increase request and the attribution of costs related to SB 1383 implementation. The purpose of this solicitation is to obtain an independent assessment separate from work previously performed by RWMA staff and R3 Consulting Group.

- **Question 2:** The Scope of Work seems to indicate that the selected proposer would only be reviewing the Extraordinary Increase. Is this assumption correct or would this EI review be included along with another increase (RRI/Index Based)?
 - **RWMA Response:** The scope of work is limited to review of the Extraordinary Increase (EI) request and associated SB 1383 cost attribution.

- **Question 3:** Is there a possibility for an extension in order to incorporate the results of the Q&A period into our proposal?
